



Cost

School bookings cost £120 per 90 minute session for a class of up to 35 pupils. (We charge £3.50 each for extra pupils.)

We expect you to bring 1 adult for every 8 pupils to supervise small groups in the Museum. These group helpers will be admitted free of charge. Any adult providing 1:1 support for a child will also be entitled to free admission. Additional adults will be charged at the normal entry price of £6.

Booking

Goody bags

We can provide goody bags for the children (and adults) in your class. Each bag contains a selection of goodies, with prices starting from £1 each. We also offer schools a 20% discount on all Roald Dahl books. Books and goody bags must be ordered at least one week in advance and should be made payable to *Roald Dahl Centre (Trading) Ltd.*

After booking

We will send you:

- letter of confirmation
- an invoice payable 28 days before your visit
- health and safety information to help with your own risk assessment
- two Golden tickets for teacher preview visits (available only for first-time visitors)
- a Village trail leaflet with readings for teachers
- directions for coach drivers

Cancellation

Please note cancellation within 28 days of your trip will incur a charge of 50% of the cost of your visit.

Teacher previews

We offer two Golden tickets per school to allow teachers to preview the Museum and carry out their own risk assessment during our opening times.
