

Please pass to your coach driver

Getting to Great Missenden

From the M40 Junction 4

- From the roundabout take the A404 towards High Wycombe.
- Continue over the first roundabout and down the hill.
- At the bottom of the hill, follow signs for A4128 towards Great Missenden (take the flyover that passes in front of the Fire Station).
- At the next roundabout take a right following the A4128 to Great Missenden.
- Pass through two mini roundabouts into Hughenden Valley.
- At the next mini roundabout take a right towards Great Missenden (up the hill).
- Pass through Great Kingshill and Prestwood; after approximately 4 miles you descend into Great Missenden.
- Pass the pay-and-display car park on Link Road that the brown Museum parking signs lead you to and stop at the coach drop off point in the Buryfield car park next to the tennis courts (see map overleaf). The Museum is a short walk away on the High Street.

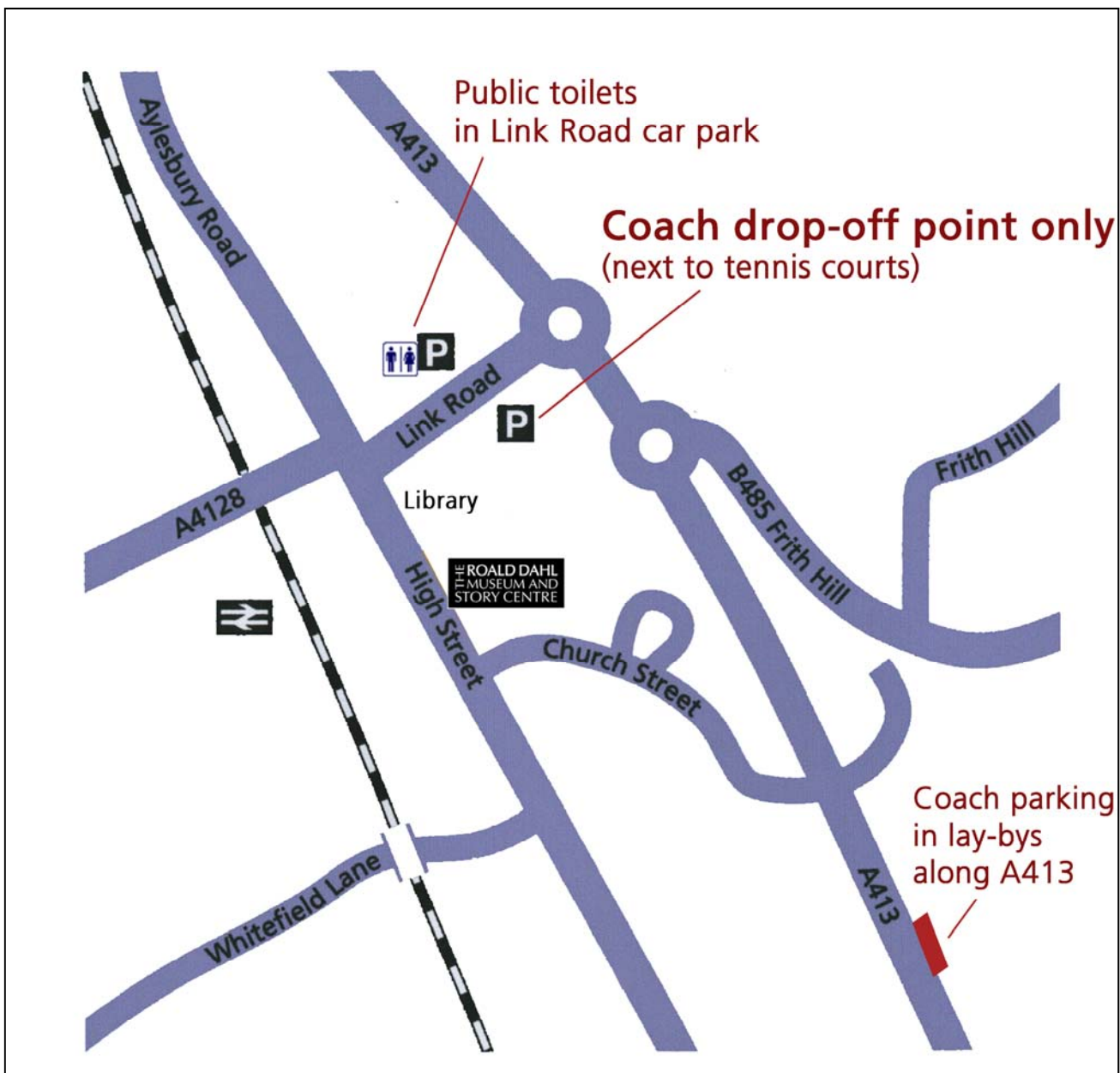
From the M4 Junction 8/9

Take the A404 to High Wycombe at the M40 "Handy Cross" roundabout then follow the above instructions.

From the M25 Junction 16

- Take the M40 in the direction of Oxford. Leave at Junction 2 "Beaconsfield".
- Head towards Beaconsfield A40 and Amersham A355.
- Once in Beaconsfield take a right at the first mini roundabout, towards Amersham A355 and after 5 miles descend into Amersham.
- Take a left at the roundabout and follow the A413 to Great Missenden and Aylesbury.
- After 4 miles you will pass under a rail bridge. Carry straight on at the next roundabout.
- At the second roundabout turn left into Great Missenden.
- Turn immediately left into the Buryfield car park and stop at the coach drop-off point next to the tennis courts (see map overleaf). The Museum is a short walk away along the High Street.

Please see overleaf for a detailed map of the village showing the coach drop off point and public toilets.



As the Museum is part of the historic High Street, there is no parking at the Museum itself. **Coaches are not allowed along the High Street** - drivers **must** use the coach **drop-off** point in the Buryfield car park off Link Road.

Please do not park or wait in the Link Road pay and display car park or along the Link Road itself. The coach drop-off point is for setting down and picking up only. **There are a number of parking bays along the A413** where coaches can wait while the class are in the Museum. Coach drivers can use the public toilets in the Link Road pay and display car park.

Pick up times:

Morning session - pick up at 12noon or 12.30pm (if the class are staying for lunch).

Afternoon session - pick up at 2pm.
